



What is Xarelto?

Xarelto (Rivaroxaban) is an anticoagulant prescription first approved by the U.S Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in 2011. It is prescribed to prevent blood clots from forming due to a certain irregular heartbeat or after a hip or knee replacement surgery.

What are the concerns?

Xarelto (Rivaroxaban) has been linked to a number of serious and even fatal side effects. Reported side effects of Xarelto include severe (irreversible, and even fatal) internal bleeding, decreased oxygen carried to red blood cells, blood clots, hematoma, hemorrhage in the brain, feeling faint, swelling of the lower limbs, loss of movement in any part of your body, abnormal liver function, easy bruising, unusual bleeding, difficulty breathing, and more. Each of these side effects is potentially serious and there is no known cure to address the most severe cases of internal bleeding caused by Xarelto medication.
