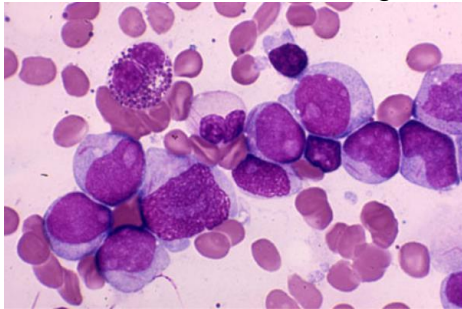
Tasigna, a product of Novartis AG Pharmaceutical, is commonly used to treat Philadelphia chromosome-positive chronic myeloid leukemia, cancer of bone marrow and blood. Tasigna is used to block chemical enzymes in cancer cells to prevent growth and division.

What You Should Know

Tasigna has been found to post life-threatening risks to patients. Tasigna was approved by the FDA in 2007 with a Black Box warning related to other Tasigna side-effects. Patients were not warned about the risk of atherosclerosis and other related complications

The **complications** associated with atherosclerosis can include:

- Thickening of arterial walls
- Chance of peripheral arterial disease
- Swelling of arteries
- Other cardiovascular problems
- Limb amputation
- Death
